- Final Injury Investigation Report from DFPS Texas Childcare Licensing 10.3.23.
  - SFEI cited for 2 deficiencies for teacher whose actions caused an injury to a child on 6.13.23. Teacher was terminated. Parents of enrolled children notified 10.5.23
  - SFEI steps taken to provide additional training, support, and supervision of teachers in the classroom.
    - All SFEI staff were counseled and completed 3 refresher courses at the beginning of July 2023 through the Texas A&M Early Childhood Education Department:
      - Positive Discipline and Guidance
      - Injury Prevention and Child Safety in Child Care Settings Child Maltreatment: A Guide for Child Care Professionals
    - Professional child care consultant Ann McKittrick and JSC counselors joined staff meetings to discuss stress reduction and managing emotional and physical health.
    - SFEI directors are performing in person and video camera observations of all classrooms and following up with classroom management support highlighting appropriate redirection practices and seeing behavior as communication.
    - Additional substitute teachers have been hired for support when staff are feeling frustrated and/or not feeling well.
    - Annual in-service professional development meeting 10.9.23 included training on developmentally appropriate behavior and classroom management.
